**WARM UP:** What are some examples of excellent craftsmanship you can think of?

### SERMON REFLECTION

- What were some key truths from Genesis that Pastor Dan featured (regarding how the world was made and about how we were made)?
- Can you think of a large project you've taken on where your work ended up being in vain?
- How does one go about building *for* and *with* the Lord?
- Have you ever expressly sought God, asking Him to reveal His plans for your life? (In your relationships, for your career, etc.) What did He reveal to you?
- Do you have any routines that help you get a good night's sleep?
- How are those who build *with* and *for* the Lord more likely to enjoy restful sleep?
- What is a work you've undertaken (or are taking on now) where you're confident it was God-directed and it won't be in vain?

- What, if anything, is holding you back from giving God a blank sheet of paper, letting Him write your story?
- What are some of the unique challenges of having a big family? The unique blessings?
- What did your parents do right in “aiming you and launching you” into the future?
- Who are some people God has used in your life to build you up?
- Is there anyone who would point to you and say, “Yes. \_\_\_\_\_ really helped me grow in and live out my faith?” What did you do to build them up?
- Is there anyone God has put on your heart to reach out to?
